We want to provide a safe haven for ALL kids to come feel welcome and accepted so they can just be themselves. No strings attached. Because kids need to be kids and just have fun. Isn't that what childhood was supposed to be about?

Youth ages 11–18 will have a place to hang out, make friends, and be themselves in a world that too often expects them to perform, conform, or disappear.

Kids can come after school to hangout, shoot pool, play games, do crafts, go online, make music, or relax with friends.

Additional activities will include teen-led clubs, creative projects, and regular special events. Down the road, we plan to offer optional tutoring, life skills, adulting, mental health support, and spiritual programs.

Many teens are struggling—with anxiety, isolation, and broken social connections. This center offers them a chance to rebuild friendships, gain confidence, and stay safe, off the streets, and out of trouble.

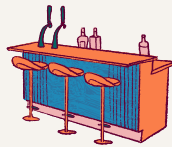

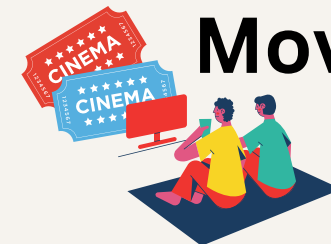
